### When:

The program will start on Sunday 9th January at 2.00 pm and will finish on Thursday 13th January at 3.30 pm. There will be an evening program most days.

### Where:

**Training** will be held each day at Morling College 120 Herring Road Eastwood, Sydney Australia.

**Accommodation** is adjacent to Morling College at Dunmore Lang College, and provides very comfortable and clean accommodation. All meals will be held at Dunmore Lang College

### How to get there:

By car, taxi or you can get to Morling and Dunmore Lang Colleges via Sydney's train network. The nearest train station is, Macquarie University Station, and is only a short walk (400mtrs) to either College.

## The Effective Teaching Series

The Effective Teaching Series was developed by New Hope International (NHI) in response to a request by the South Sea Evangelical Church in the Solomon Islands for training to help make their schools Christian.

It is part of the "Education for Change" program which aims to bring hope to people in less developed countries.

The course has three in-service programs for teachers that can be delivered in a one-week intensive or as shorter two-hour sessions over a longer period:

1. Introduction to Christian Teaching
2. Approaches to Teaching and Learning
3. Implementing an Effective Curriculum

NHI provides "Effective Teaching" textbooks and training manuals for schools in less developed countries either **free**, if schools cannot afford payment, or at **subsidised cost**. NHI depends on voluntary giving of Christian teachers in Australia and New Zealand to be able to continue to support schools in developing countries in this way.

## Training Approaches

New Hope International (NHI) aims to train national educators who will train teachers in their own country using the material provided by NHI.

Experienced Christian teachers in Australia and New Zealand are needed to be trained as Accredited Trainers who can teach educators in other countries to be trainers in the Effective Teaching Series. Teachers and other educators can be trained as Accredited Trainers at one of the NHI annual International Training Seminars.

The 2011 International Training Seminar will offer courses in Phase 1, 2 or 3. This five-day intensive training seminar is offered each year in Sydney to equip people to present the Effective Teaching Training seminars to teachers and principals in other countries. Successful participants will be accredited to use NHI courses and material that may be presented in other countries around the world. God has continued to bless this approach to assisting Christian Schools in many countries!

God's blessing has been evident wherever this material has been taught, with teachers being converted or having a new vision for teaching and in some cases even whole school communities have experienced revival.

## The Needs Are Great

At present, NHI's Effective Teaching Series is being taught each year in countries such as the Solomon Islands, Papua New Guinea, Tanzania, Thailand, Vanuatu, Nepal, Kenya and Uganda and in 2011, NHI is planning to expand into India.

Australian and New Zealand schools who have teachers already trained in the Effective Teaching Series are also working in countries as a part of their schools mission outreach in countries such as Vanuatu, Kenya, India and Fiji. There are also trained teachers who are assisting their own schools with some PD utilizing the Effective Teaching Series course materials.

There is an ever increasing demand for the Effective Teaching Series training, and accredited trained teachers are constantly required to meet this demand by assisting us in presenting this course around the world.
