Research

Avondale researchers have been investigating teachers' perspectives of the impact of COVID-19 shutdowns, and how they perceive the future, for ASA (Adventist Schools Australia). What are teachers' perspectives on the journey of Adventist schools in managing the COVID-19 response, especially during the school shutdown and on return to face-to-face teaching? The study will also look at their perceptions of what the 'new normal' for education may look like in the future.

One paper has been published and two are awaiting publication.

A further study is being carried out that relates to COVID-19 in schools. The purpose of this research is to explore school

chaplains' perceptions of the impact of COVID-19 on their roles in support of school students and staff, as well as the challenges, supports, sense of belonging, purpose and mission of these school chaplains.
